



African Traditional Religion
Followers = 100 million, primarily in Africa
Views of God = Animism/Polytheism
Means to God = Sacrifices
Animism is the spiritual belief that all creation ... has
animation or life within it



Chinese Traditional Religion

- Followers = 394 million (mostly in China)
- Founders = Lao-Tzu (604 531 BC) and Confucius (551 479 BC)
- View of God = No particular deity/impersonal force Means to God = more of an ethical system than a religious one

Buddhism
Followers = 488 million
Founder = Siddhartha Gautama (563 – 483 BC)
View of God = not stressed
Means to God = The Four Noble Truths
Four Noble Truths
1. Suffering is universal
2. Craving is the root cause of suffering
3. The cure for suffering is to eliminate craving
4. Craving is eliminated by following the Eightfold Path:
(1) Right views (2) Right Thought (3) Right speech
(4) Right behavior (5) Right occupation (6) Right effort
  (7) Right contemplation (8) Right meditation

Hinduism
Followers = 1 billion
Founded = 1800 - 1000 BC
View of God = Pantheism
Means to God = The Transmigration of Souls/Reincarnation
View of the Afterlife = "Release"

Hindus <u>believe</u> there is one uniform force in the universe to meld into the inanimate force of the universe, to be <u>reabsorbed</u> into the great cosmic unconsciousness

Hindus view of God is called <u>pantheism</u>. This belief is that God is <u>in everything</u> and <u>everything</u> is <u>God</u>

Secularism/Nonreligious/Agnostics/Atheists

Followers = 1.1 billion – nonreligious; agnostics and atheists

"Sociologists point out that there are no truly 'secular' societies.' . . . 'Nonreligious' people . . . are those who derive their worldview and value system from alternative, secular, cultural or otherwise nonrevealed systems rather than traditional religious systems."

- Followers = 1.6 Billion
- Founder = <u>Muhammad</u>
- View of God = Monotheism
- Means to God = The Five Pillars of Islam
- View of the Afterlife = Paradise
- Five Pillars of Islam
- 1. <u>Recite</u> the Shahada = which is the Islamic creed that states,
- "There is no god but Allah, and Muhammad is his prophet."
- 2. Pray five times a day facing the city of Mecca
- 3. Give to the poor
- 4. Fast during daylight hours during the month of Ramadan
- 5. Hajj—Take a <u>pilgrimage</u> to Mecca at least once in your life,

Christianity is the largest religion in the world

- Followers = 2.2 billion
- Founder = Jesus Christ
- View of God = Monotheism
- Means to God = Atonement/Substitution
- View of the Afterlife = Heaven
- "For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God" 1 Peter 3:18

Heaven is a place in the <u>presence of God</u> Himself, where we will have meaningful <u>responsibilities</u> full knowledge of <u>ourselves</u> and <u>God</u> and experience unspeakable <u>joy</u>

'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away" Revelation 21:4
