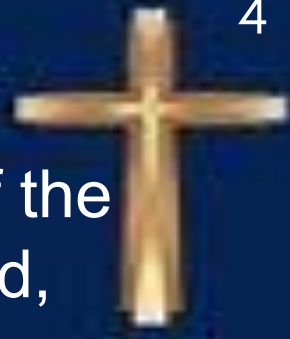
“Rejoice always, pray without ceasing
