SURRENDER, PART 1

13 Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.

(Romans 6:13)

Facing imminent crucifixion, Jesus prays in Luke 22:42

"Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done." SURRENDER IS A POWERFUL ACT OF COURAGE AND WISDOM, ENABLING ONE TO FIND PEACE AND MOVE FORWARD MORE HARMONIOUSLY IN ALIGNMENT WITH GOD.

PROVERBS 3:5 "TRUST IN THE LORD WITH ALL YOUR HEART AND LEAN NOT ON YOUR OWN UNDERSTANDING"

WHAT APPEARS TO BE THE RIGHT CHOICE MAY IN FACT BE THE WRONG CHOICE.

PROVERBS 14:12 "THERE IS A WAY THAT APPEARS TO BE RIGHT, BUT IN THE END IT LEADS TO DEATH."

JUST BECAUSE WE'RE IN OVER OUR HEADS DOES NOT MEAN GOD IS NO LONGER IN CONTROL.

ISAIAH 41:10 "SO DO NOT FEAR, FOR I AM WITH YOU; DO NOT BE DISMAYED, FOR I AM YOUR GOD. I WILL STRENGTHEN YOU AND HELP YOU; I WILL UPHOLD YOU WITH MY RIGHTEOUS RIGHT HAND."

ABRAHAM'S CALL TO SACRIFICE ISAAC.

GENESIS 22: 1-2 "1 Some time later God tested Abraham. He said to him, "Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied. ² Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love—Isaac—and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you."

ABRAHAM DIDN'T DELAY GENESIS 22:3

"EARLY THE NEXT MORNING, ABRAHAM GOT UP AND LOADED HIS DONKEY. HE TOOK WITH HIM TWO OF HIS SERVANTS AND HIS SON ISAAC. When he had cut enough wood for the BURNT OFFERING, HE SET OUT FOR THE PLACE GOD HAD TOLD HIM ABOUT."

THE LORD HAD PROMISED ABRAHAM THAT HE WOULD ESTABLISH HIS COVENANT WITH ISAAC AND HIS DESCENDANTS IN GENESIS 17:19

"THEN GOD SAID, "YES, BUT YOUR WIFE SARAH WILL BEAR YOU A SON, AND YOU WILL CALL HIM ISAAC. I WILL ESTABLISH MY COVENANT WITH HIM AS AN EVERLASTING COVENANT FOR HIS DESCENDANTS AFTER HIM."

The writer of Hebrews explained Abraham's faith in Hebrews 11:19

"ABRAHAM REASONED THAT GOD COULD EVEN RAISE THE DEAD, AND SO IN A MANNER OF SPEAKING HE DID RECEIVE ISAAC BACK FROM DEATH."

ISAAC MUST HAVE BEEN IN HIS LATE TEENS OR EARLY TWENTIES. WE CAN KNOW THIS BY THE QUESTIONS ISAAC ASKED OF ABRAHAM IN GENESIS 22:7

"ISAAC SPOKE UP AND SAID TO HIS FATHER ABRAHAM, "FATHER?" "YES, MY SON?" ABRAHAM REPLIED. "THE FIRE AND WOOD ARE HERE," ISAAC SAID, "BUT WHERE IS THE LAMB FOR THE BURNT OFFERING?"

AND IN VERSE 6:

"ABRAHAM TOOK THE WOOD FOR THE BURNT OFFERING AND PLACED IT ON HIS SON ISAAC, AND HE HIMSELF CARRIED THE FIRE AND THE KNIFE. AS THE TWO OF THEM WENT ON TOGETHER."

THE ACT OF SURRENDER DOESN'T ALWAYS MEAN WE LOSE SOMETHING WE WANT; INSTEAD, IT OFTEN LEADS TO SOMETHING GREATER THAN OURSELVES.

LUKE 9:23 JESUS EXPLAINS THAT "WHOEVER WANTS TO BE MY DISCIPLE MUST DENY THEMSELVES AND TAKE UP THEIR CROSS DAILY AND FOLLOW ME."

AND IN 2 TIMOTHY 3:12, PAUL TELLS TIMOTHY, "IN FACT, EVERYONE WHO WANTS TO LIVE A GODLY LIFE IN CHRIST JESUS WILL BE PERSECUTED."

When we lead a life surrendered to Christ, we put Christ first.

BIBLICAL SURRENDER MEANS TRUSTING IN JESUS, EVEN WHEN WE DON'T UNDERSTAND, ESPECIALLY WHEN THINGS SPIRAL OUT OF CONTROL OR OUR WORLD IS CRASHING DOWN.

ISAIAH 26:3 ENCOURAGES US TO TRUST:

"YOU WILL KEEP IN PERFECT PEACE THOSE WHOSE MINDS ARE STEADFAST, BECAUSE THEY TRUST IN YOU."

Philippians 4:6-7 Teaches Us To Hold This Truth Close To Our Obedience And Trust.

"6 DO NOT BE ANXIOUS ABOUT ANYTHING, BUT IN EVERY SITUATION, BY PRAYER AND PETITION, WITH THANKSGIVING, PRESENT YOUR REQUESTS TO GOD. 7 AND THE PEACE OF GOD, WHICH TRANSCENDS ALL UNDERSTANDING, WILL GUARD YOUR HEARTS AND YOUR MINDS IN CHRIST JESUS."

ISAIAH EXHIBITED SURRENDER BY RESPONDING TO GOD'S CALL TO BE A PROPHET WITHOUT HESITATION. DESPITE FEELING UNWORTHY AND INADEQUATE, AS HE STATES IN ISAIAH 6:5:

"Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty."

We read his bold and confident response to the Lord from Isaiah 6:8,

"THEN I HEARD THE VOICE OF THE LORD SAYING, "WHOM SHALL I SEND?" "AND WHO WILL GO FOR US?" AND I SAID, "HERE AM I SEND ME!"

JOSEPH'S STORY TEACHES US THE POWER OF FORGIVENESS, RESILIENCE, PATIENCE, AND COMPLETE TRUST IN GOD REGARDLESS OF LIFE'S CHALLENGES.

GENESIS 50:20

"YOU INTENDED TO HARM ME, BUT GOD INTENDED IT FOR GOOD TO ACCOMPLISH WHAT IS NOW BEING DONE, THE SAVING OF MANY LIVES."

GOD WILL RESHAPE US AS IT SEEMS BEST TO HIM!

JEREMIAH 18:6

"He said, "Can I not do with you, Israel, as this potter does?" declares the Lord. "Like clay in the hand of the potter, so are you in my hand, Israel."

C.S. Lewis: "God doesn't want something from us; He simply wants us"

YOU DON'T HAVE TO BE A DIFFERENT YOU BEFORE GOD; YOU CAN BE THE REAL YOU WITH HIM. HE FORMED YOU AND HAS ALWAYS KNOWN YOU.

JEREMIAH 1:5

"BEFORE I FORMED YOU IN THE WOMB I KNEW YOU, BEFORE YOU WERE BORN I SET YOU APART; I APPOINTED YOU AS A PROPHET TO THE NATIONS." GOD KNOWS YOUR THOUGHTS, YOUR HEART, AND YOUR INTENTIONS, AND HE LOVES YOU COMPLETELY, DESPITE OUR FLAWS, FOR HE HAS CALLED YOU FOR A PURPOSE, SO YOU CAN CONFIDENTLY APPROACH HIM.

HEBREWS 4:16

"LET US THEN APPROACH GOD'S THRONE OF GRACE WITH CONFIDENCE, SO THAT WE MAY RECEIVE MERCY AND FIND GRACE TO HELP US IN OUR TIME OF NEED."

1 Peter 5:7 tells us to go before God and

"CAST ALL YOUR ANXIETY ON HIM BECAUSE HE CARES FOR YOU."

BIBLE TEACHER AND AUTHOR GARY THOMAS, IN HIS BOOK "SEEKING THE FACE OF GOD," REFERENCES GENESIS 32:24-30, STATING THAT

"There will likely be a time in our Christian Journeys when, like Jacob, we will wrestle with God all night long... But there must eventually come a dawn when we say, "OK, God, You win... Not My will but Thine be done."

DO YOU FEAR WHAT A LIFESTYLE OF FULL SURRENDER MIGHT COST YOU? IF YOU DO, THEN TAKE A MOMENT TO CONSIDER THE COST OF HOLDING OUT ON GOD. RESISTANCE IS FAR MORE COSTLY THAN SURRENDER.
