Hebrews 1:1-2

"Long ago God spoke many times and in many ways to our ancestors through the prophets. ² And now in these final days, he has spoken to us <u>through his Son</u>. God promised everything to the Son as an inheritance, and <u>through the Son</u> he <u>created</u> the universe."

Genesis 1:26

"Let <u>us</u> make human beings in our image, to be like <u>us</u>. They will reign over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, the livestock, all the wild animals on the earth, and the small animals that scurry along the ground"

Colossians 1:15

"Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation,

¹⁶ for through him God created everything.....Everything was created <u>through him</u> and <u>for him.</u>

Hebrews 1:3

"The Son radiates God's own glory"

John 1:3-5

"Through him (Jesus) all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. ⁴ In him (Jesus) was life, and that life was the <u>light</u> of men. ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it"

Hebrews 1:3

"The Son radiates God's own glory and <u>expresses</u> the <u>very</u> <u>character of God</u>,... and he sustains everything by the mighty power of his command. When he had cleansed us from our sins, he sat down in the place of honor at the right hand of the majestic God in heaven."

- 1. Reflecting on Hebrews 1:1-3, how does understanding of 'Jesus as Greater'.....'Jesus as God's final word'... influence your perception of His authority and role in your life?
